Acceptance as a Doctoral Student

Your request to be accepted as a doctoral student has been granted. With this acceptance you are obligated to participate in a structured doctoral program of the Faculty of Biosciences (Blue Sheet), or the EMBL-PhD program. The successful participation in this doctoral program must be confirmed by the *Proof of Attendance of the PhD Program* (Blue Sheet), submitted together with the form *Application for Admission to the Examination for a Doctoral Degree*, at the point of thesis submission.

The starting date of your doctoral research is determined to be (refer to German text), at which point the allowed five-year PhD period begins.

This *Acceptance as a Doctoral Student* is valid for five years. This period may be extended only in exceptional cases (sickness, maternity leave, etc.), which must be substantiated with an *Application for Extension*. If you intend to change your work group and/or scientific supervisor, the change must be approved by the *Doctoral Degree Committee*, as stated in section 5, article 6 of the *Doctoral Degree Regulations*.
